Mr. Kurt Terpgaard-Jensen has substantial environmental experience (more than 30 years) from the public and private sector as director, manager and environmental expert within various fields.

Mr. Jensen has considerable practical management experience from local government in Denmark as Technical Director in a municipality and as Environmental Director in the Storstroem Province administration. Mr. Jensen experience includes practical and theoretical waste management.

During the 1980 and 1990 he took part in the establishment of the inter-municipal waste management companies in Denmark. The task included waste master planning, establishment of waste facilities (e.g. incinerators, landfills, HZW facilities, etc.) and environmental impact assessment of the facilities. Later in the process co-generation (production of heat and electricity) became an issue as well as special waste management (hospital waste, electronic waste, etc.)

Mr. Jensen international career started in the early nineties. He has considerable experience as team leader and capacity building expert. In 1992 he was assigned as Environmental Advisor of EU PHARE Project Management Unit (PMU) in Bratislava in Slovak Republic. From mid nineties he worked as an international capacity building expert (TNA, CAN, training including Curricula and HRD). In Central and Eastern Europe he has worked in Serbia, Kosovo, Bulgaria, Slovakia, Latvia, Lithuania and Poland. Outside Europe he has worked in Bhutan, Malaysia, Indonesia, Vietnam, Egypt, Jordan, Botswana and South Africa.
